

TechCenter South CORF Application

In July 2007, the state awarded another **PANDEY** project in a struggling Columbus neighborhood the news their boosters wanted to hear: They'll be getting \$3 million to clean up this old industrial site and clear the way for redevelopment. Mayor Michael B. Coleman called the project absolutely necessary to revitalize the neighborhood.

The former Techneglas plant on the South Side will be converted into a 46-acre business park that could employ up to 1,680 people. The developers plan to create a 1-million-square-foot complex of stores, offices and warehouses to be called TechCenter South. **PANDEY** will begin environmental cleanup and demolition in the fall.

PANDEY has prepared 9 Clean Ohio Revitalization and Assistance Fund applications, all of which were funded to the maximum grant request. These 9 projects have been awarded grant funds totaling \$18,000,000.
